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SURFACE PREPARATION	 This product should be applied to a surface that has been blast cleaned properly. Remove all wax, oil and grease by solvent cleaning in accordance with the guidelines given by SSPC-SPI. Where necessary remove weld spatter and round off all rough weld seams and sharp edges to a smooth surface. Abrasive blast clean to a minimum standard of Sa 2 ½ Swedish Standard SIS 05 59 00 or ISO 8501-1 : 1988 Any surface defects revealed by blast cleaning should be ground, filled or treated in a suitable manner. An average surface profile of 50 microns is acceptable, but this average should not exceed 75 microns. After blasting, remove dust from the surface. The surface to be coated must also be clean and dry. For Non ferrous metal such as GI, Aluminium & Copper: Wire brushing / emery paper cleaning to remove all traces of adherent dirt etc. Then clean the surface with BERGER TOOL CLEANER prior to painting with EPILUX 70.
